### Return to Play Participant 'Opt In' Form

The purpose of this 'Opt In' form is to invite you, in your capacity as a player, to return to playing softball in the context of the coronavirus (Covid-19) pandemic (“**Return to play**”); and to set out the terms and conditions which you must comply with if you wish to return to play.

**Please note that you are not required to return to play, and if you choose not to return to play then you will not face discrimination by us. If you do 'opt in' and subsequently change your mind, you may withdraw your consent at any time by contacting Steve Lyons, the club president & Covid-19 officer.**

I, the Participant, hereby confirm and agree that I wish to return to play; and in doing so I confirm that:

- (i) I do not have, and nobody in my household has (including within the past 14 days), any of the symptoms of coronavirus, as set out on the [NHS website](#)<sup>1</sup> from time to time, including without limitation a high temperature, a new continuous cough, or a loss or change to sense of smell or taste;
- (ii) I will immediately inform the Activity Provider if I (or anybody with whom I have been in close contact) develop coronavirus symptoms. In such circumstances, I shall follow the Government's guidance in relation to self-isolating and I shall not attend the Activity Provider's events;
- (iii) I will comply with all relevant guidance, rules, policies and advice published or made available from time to time by the Government, the World Health Organisation and the Activity Provider in relation to coronavirus, including without limitation in relation to applicable social distancing measures;
- (iv) I understand and accept the potential risks associated with returning to play in the context of the coronavirus pandemic, including without limitation the risk of unintended transmission of the disease, and I will comply with all of the Activity Provider's reasonable instructions in connection with coronavirus;
- (v) If required by the Activity Provider from time to time, I agree to complete a medical declaration form prior to being permitted to attend the Activity Provider's events. I acknowledge that any failure to do so may result in access being denied; and

(vi) I give my consent to my personal data (including any 'special category personal data', such as data pertaining to my health) being processed by or on behalf of the Activity Provider, in accordance with the terms of its Privacy Policy\* from time to time. Further, I consent to my personal data being used for the purposes of health and safety, including without limitation in connection with the Government's coronavirus Test and Trace<sup>2</sup> policy.
